Building the ecosystem for social entrepreneurship

- Over 20 national stakeholders joined our research efforts to understand the ecosystem of social entrepreneurship in Romania, and build the social business incubation model.
- Three key human-centered educational resources were developed to be used by European organizations in incubating social businesses. Check the resources here: https://wegrowideas.eu/selc-community/
- 15 facilitators from Romania, Cyprus, and Italy were trained to use SELC resources with would-be or new entrepreneurs.



Connecting social entrepreneurs with VET

- 27 VET providers and social entrepreneurs helped us to explore the social enterprise sector and its interaction with the education system and work placement programmes run by VET and higher education institutions. The collected data, available here, is used to design a framework of collaboration between the two sectors.
- 10 VET & social enterprise staff from the UK, Sweden, Italy and Romania were trained and involved in the development of the framework.



Digital Skills and Future Skills for Young People

Enhancing media literacy & civic engagement of young people through storytelling & design thinking

- 25 young people piloted MILagers Design Thinking Journeys.
- Over 20 young people and other relevant stakeholders were involved in the development of the media literacy game.
- Three key educational resources on design thinking & storytelling were created.

Supporting young people to better adapt to the labor market by improving their emotional intelligence

- 50 young people supported us to design the EILM emotional intelligence
- Approx. 10 local stakeholders were involved in the development of EILM educational resources.
- Three key educational resources on EQ were created

- 12 staff from Norway, Finland, and Romania learned and shared their media and youth civic engagement expertise in an international training course.

Promoting digital skills and future skills in the youth sector

- Four digital learning tools and resources were developed and promoted within the youth sector in Romania, Norway, Ireland, and Poland.
- 21 youth workers were trained to deliver digitally enhanced workshops on 21stcentury skills for young people.
- 77 young people from Romania developed their digital and 21st-century skills.
